Work Experience requires Resilience and Respect

In addition to our 6th-formers, Year 10 students have had experience of the world of work

We are very fortunate to have some wonderful vocational experience opportunities locally. This year so far, students have been supported by staff to work in the local village shop, at the local Foodbank, a farm and a large-scale growing nursery.

Year 10 student have been able to spend time at a nearby junior school, working alongside the PE teacher and in a retail outlet: in both cases, they have made us very proud indeed.

This work also contributes to a Vocational Qualification that students can complete, at the level that suits them.







Qualification Success

ARTS

Four students: Connor, Kai, Andre and Dennis, all achieved their Bronze Arts Award this ½ term: something they have been working on since the summer term 2017. This Level 1 qualification requires students to participate in an Arts event, improve their skills in an artistic venture of their choice, teach



someone else an Arts skill they have learnt and research their personal hero from the Arts world. Every single portfolio was unique and covered topics such as Body Orchestra, Charcoal Drawing, Theatre and African Drumming. These qualifications not only introduce young people to areas of the Arts they may be unfamiliar with, encouraging their curiosity and developing creativity but they also require students to work independently and demonstrate resilience as they hone their chosen crafts.

ENGLISH FUNCTIONAL SKILLS

The first formal examinations of the year took place this half-term and we are thrilled for Dennis and Connor in their achievement of their Level 1 English qualifications, with flying colors!

SPEAKING AND LISTENING

GCSE and Functional Skills examinations both require students to make formal presentations to an audience and take part in formal discussions. This half-term the school was externally



moderated by the examination board. Kai, Andre, Dennis and Connor participated in fantastic debates about the way disposable plastic was destroying the environment and what should be done about it. Their formal presentations to their peers focused on healthy eating, the evil of take-away food and health necessity for young people to be active as possible.
