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## Broadlands Hall School Qualification Results 2019



2019 was the best achievement year so far for students at Broadlands Hall School, with more GCSEs and Level 1 / 2 ASDAN qualifications being taken than ever previously. All students exceeded their personal targets and the expectations from time of entry into the school. Students at Broadlands Hall School study a broad range of certificates and qualifications. Frequently there are only one or two students taking each qualification. Students were entered for a wide range of ASDAN, Gateway and Edexcel qualifications from Pre-Entry Functional Skills to GCSE.

## Broadlands Hall School Qualification Results 2016



Students at Broadlands Hall School study a broad range of certificates and qualifications. Frequently there is only one or two students taking each qualification.

We offer Pre- Entry Level Qualifications and Entry Level Qualifications (ELQ) that are designed and assessed by mainstream exam boards and which sit below GCSE grades. We also offer GCSEs and BTEC qualifications for the most able students. Each student's certificate and qualification pathway is unique to them.
